


Infection Control Measures

- Based on the Tokyo Metropolitan Government's basic policy on measures against infectious diseases (*1), we plan to implement the following measures in cooperation with the venue.
- The content of the measures may change depending on the situation, but we will take sufficient measures.

- · Organizing staff will wear masks, disinfect hands, and take daily temperature.
- · The number of seats will be half of the full capacity and the number of visitors will be limited.
- · We will alert visitors to infectious disease countermeasures before and after the event.
- We ask visitors to wear masks, disinfect their hands, and engage in social distancing.
- We will do temperature check at the reception and refuse visitors with fever.
- · We ask participants to try to secure physical distance in case of congestion.
- At lunchtime, to avoid congestion at nearby restaurants, we will distribute a lunch box. We ask participants not to talk without a mask while eating.
- For food and drink, we will use a company that has taken measures against infectious diseases approved by the venue.
- The distance between the stage and the audience is long enough (2 meters or more as recommended by the Tokyo Metropolitan Government).
- · We disinfect microphones every day, while each room has a disinfectant spray for microphones.


